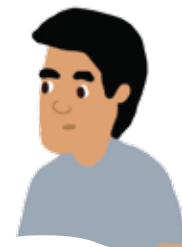

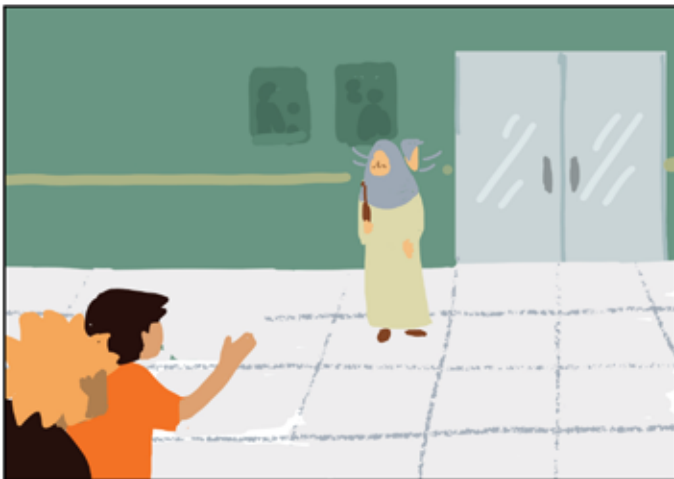


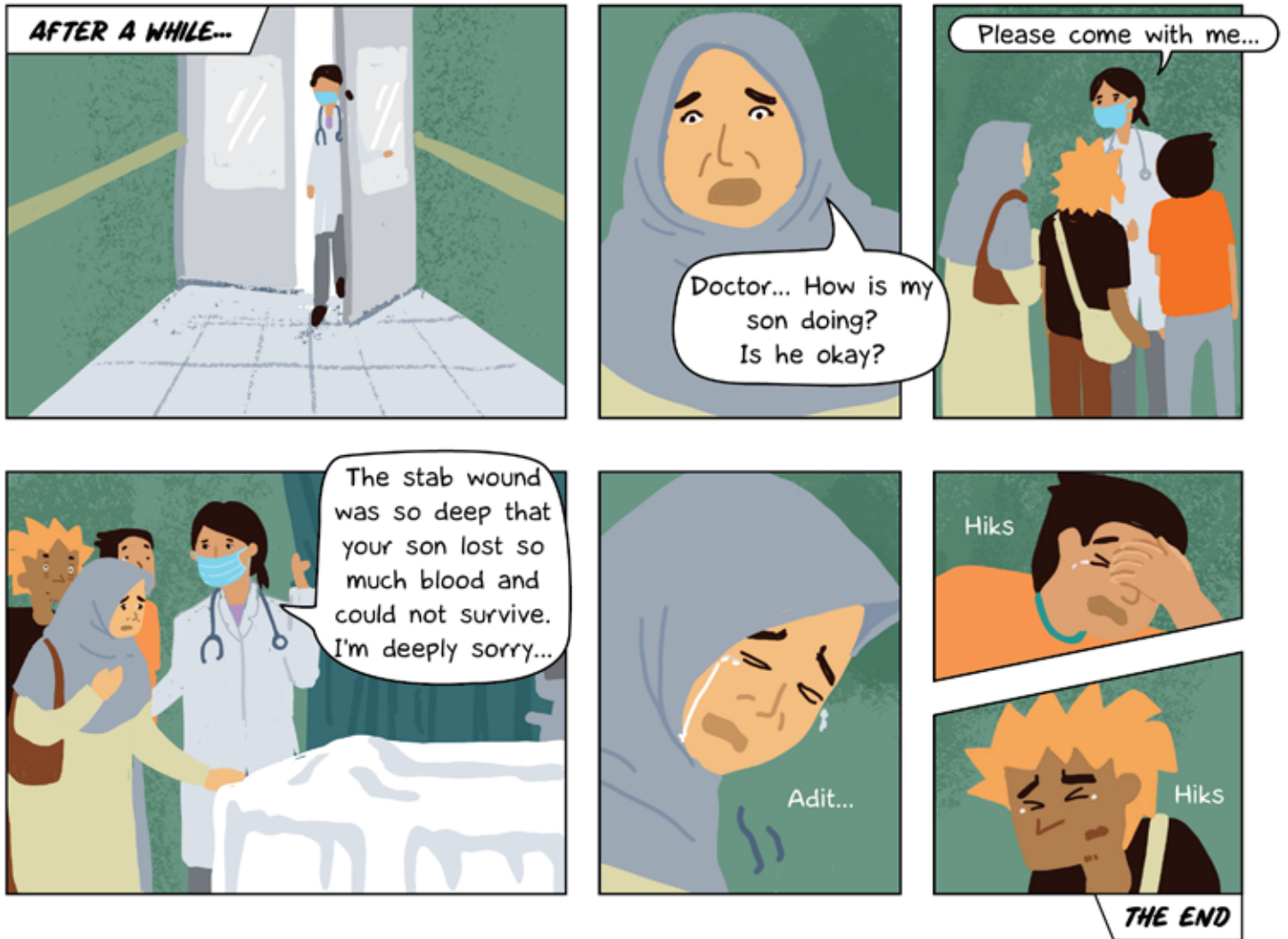












### The Background of Mobile Arts for Peace (MAP) Research Project

MAP uses arts-based approaches to improve young people's (12 to 24 years) participation in voicing out social problems, involvement in decision making, and informing social policies. MAP is implemented in four countries: Indonesia, Rwanda, Nepal, and Kyrgyzstan.

The *JANGAN* (Don't) comic booklet was created by MAP young researchers, based on the social problem analysis conducted by Children's Forum of Cipinang Besar Utara in Jakarta.
